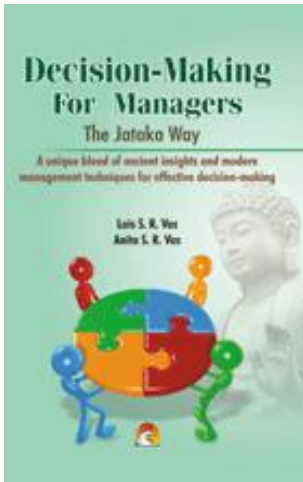




Decision-making For Managers The Jataka Way
